**Falmouth Scientific Receives Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR) Award
from the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command**

(July 29, 2005 – Cataumet, MA) FSI has won a Phase I SBIR award from the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command. The project, titled “Station-Keeping Gateway Buoy”, will build upon FSI’s current communications buoy to design an autonomous station-keeping version. FSI will address the following developmental areas: an improved hydrodynamic shape to reduce power consumption, alternative energy sources to provide power, propulsion to maintain station without mooring lines, and an improved overall design to extend mission duration and obstacle avoidance. FSI will use its knowledge from its previous moored gateway buoys as well as its revolutionary Solar AUV to provide a new completed design.
